45/18 Apologies – Cllr Sarah Helliwell

46/18 Declarations – none

47/18 Minutes of the previous meeting approved and signed

48/18 Matters Arising

- a) GDPR (Data Protection) to be made a separate agenda item for the next agenda and until further notice.
- b) A Byford informed Councillors that installation of communication masts for the emergency services network will be put back until 2022.
- c) We are awaiting money from Tesco which will be used to refurbish Fairholmes roundabout. Methods to prevent sheep gaining access to the roundabout were discussed including a low fence which has been agreed by Highways.
- d) According to DALC, the Information Commissioners Office requires councils to pay £40 for administrative costs for implementing the new GDPR regulations or face fines. However, we have not received an invoice nor been officially notified. Cllr Robinson has emailed the ICO but has had no response.

49/18 Highways and footpaths

- a) Cracks and dips in the A57 road at Drs Gate, Gillott lane end, west of The Snake Inn and on the Ladybower bends are becoming more pronounced. Report to Highways.
- b) Blackden Bridge footpath is blocked with fallen trees that have washed down the river. Report to National Trust.
- c) There has been an increase in the number of crimes where small items are being stolen from gardens. Ask parishioners to lock sheds and to be vigilant.

- a) Emails from Derbyshire Police and Mobile Library routes sent round to parishioners.
- b) National Fell Running Relays. Tim Tett in touch with NT, STW etc with a view to holding the event at Fairholmes in October 2019. Reply with same objections as last time.
- c) Emails from PDNPA regarding organised outdoor events – noted.

51/18 PDNPA Parishes Day attended by Cllrs Gascoigne & Robinson. Theme was on thriving communities. Very good presentation given by Grindleford village shop.

52/18 Hope Valley Forum meeting attended by Cllr Robinson. Forum secretary to email PC members about the cost of Smart Water for each household. Bamford with Thornhill PC has agreed that we can join with them in order to keep costs down. Agreed that we wait for the costing information before asking households if they would like to join the scheme.

53/18 Proposed new building at Fairholmes Visitor Centre. Councillors met with representatives from STW and Fisher German to see proposed plans for the building and to discuss concerns. Councillors were in favour of extending the existing building to house a café and museum rather than having a new building plus retain the existing. We were informed that there will not be a consultation period prior to applying for planning permission. Thank you to Cllr Middleton who attended our MP's coffee morning to talk to her about our concerns regarding the proposed new building.
